The repairs to the Bungoma Bible School building are nearly complete.



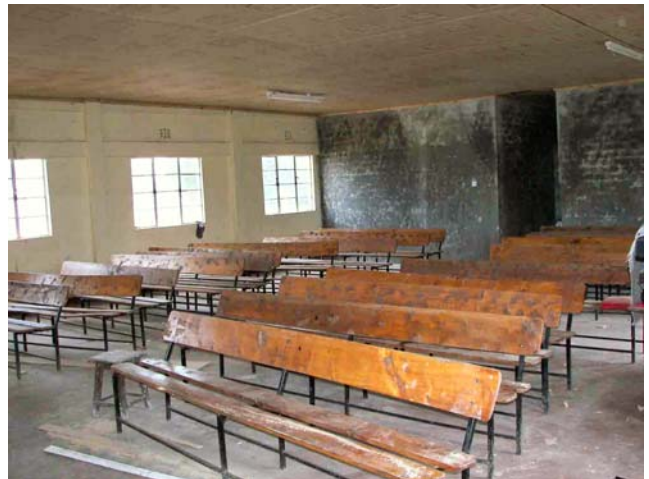
See the new roof in the picture above. You can also see where the gable ends were repaired after the wind broke the rafters out of the wall. This picture does not show the new gutter system that will better protect the roof from future wind damage. We also installed "hurricane braces" to better hold the roof on in high winds. When the roof was blown off, the rain destroyed the ceiling and the upstairs wooden classroom walls. Actually, the walls were framed with studs and the wall was a very thin manufactured plywood material. That plywood material disintegrated when it got wet. It was so thin that sound traveled throughout the upstairs area and made it hard to teach classes.



When the walls were replaced, it was decided to rebuild them with bricks. You can see the bricks in this picture. The walls will be plastered and painted.



This is a picture of our new ceiling tiles. They will also be painted white for better light distribution.



This is a picture of the upstairs auditorium. We use this for 5:00 AM daily prayer meetings, daily lunch hour meetings and for meetings with the whole student body.
