

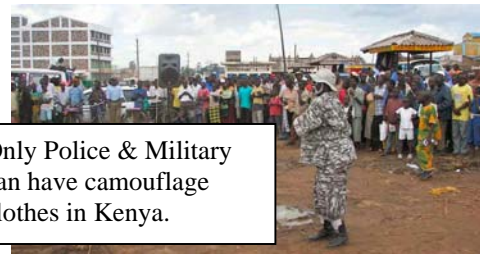
NEKESA - "The Harvester" October, 2008

A large crowd had gathered in anticipation of the meeting but they panicked when they saw Brother Lumbasi and his team arrive in uniform in a police vehicle. They thought the officers had come to arrest them! When they got out of their police vehicle and began to lead them in praising God the people were surprised and gave them their rapt attention. Then when they ministered hope and deliverance, many responded to the invitation to receive Jesus as Lord.

This week has been one of those times when God was free to move and many were saved. Forty to sixty people came forward at every crusade meeting to give their lives to the Lord. The revival meetings focused on how the Lord will have us rebuild our lives and ministry using the perspective Nehemiah had when he rebuilt the walls of Jerusalem.
