## Breakthrough to Victory!

Do you have a dream or a need but you feel hedged in, pressed on every side, troubled and oppressed in every way? Are you embarrassed, perplexed and unable to find your way out? Does it seem that you are persecuted, hard driven, deserted and struck down to the ground? Those are strategies of the devil to defeat and destroy you. (2 Corinthians 4:8-9)

**God wants you to Breakthrough to Victory!** In the face of all the attacks of the enemy, God says that we are not cramped, crushed, not driven to despair, deserted or struck out or destroyed. *God's desire for our lives is that we make constant progress.*

We are not designed to be contained or restricted. So every time there is an attempt to restrict us, we react and resist those forces that seek to contain us. When we successfully overcome those forces, a breakthrough is said to have occurred. **"Breakthrough" in the scriptural context is not a noun - it is a verb. "Breakthrough" is not something that happens to you, it is something that you do.**

The Word says that there are two types of forces that resist us: natural and demonic. Psalm 18:29 says that **by God** we can run through a troop (of demons) and leap over a wall (of natural obstacles). How do we get God's power to help us breakthrough to victory?

There are three laws for making a breakthrough.

1. The law of revelation.
2. The law of ability.
3. The law of responsibility.

We see all three of these laws in God's first words to man. He said, "Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it; and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the birds of the heavens, and over every living thing that moved upon the earth." (Genesis 1:28)

The **law of revelation** says that we must know God's will for us. God revealed His will for man in this verse. He made us to be rulers and overcomers!

The **law of ability** says that God has given us the power to act. God gave them the power to act in His revealed will for them. God's ability is an established constant - it is unshakeable and unchangeable. If we are not breaking through, it is not because God lacks the ability, it is because we are not harnessing or maximizing our own ability. Jesus said that, as His disciples, we will bear much fruit. (John 15:8) Paul wrote that **I can do all things through Christ, which strengthened me.** (Philippians 4:14) So we know that God has given us the needed ability.

The **law of responsibility** says that when we have revelation and ability that we are required to act, do and complete. *James 2:17,20 - "Faith without works is dead"*

We have an opponent who comes only to steal, kill and destroy but we have a Lord who came that we might have abundant life! Jesus said that, **"In the world ye shall have tribulation but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world."** (John 16:33) The Word goes on to tell us that there are always battles to be won before the breakthrough comes; it says that our walk with God will be a journey of ups and downs. We are continually going from victory to victory and glory to glory! But between them we often are in the valley of the shadow of death and we struggle. The greater the victories, the more difficult the battles become. If you are in the midst of an impossible situation, remember that all things can be (are possible) to him who believes! (Mark 9: 23) It also says that, "For thou wilt save the afflicted (*humble, dependent*) people; but wilt bring down high looks (*proud people*). (Ps 18:27)

And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not. (Galatians 6:9)

*Don't faint! Don't give up! Don't give in!  
Don't retreat and don't dig in! No right turn,  
no left turn, no u-turn! Keep fighting; this is  
just the final battle before the breakthrough!  
This is your Gethsemane trial!*

You can win this! Don't let the devil steal it!

We love you and stand in agreement with you for your breakthrough to be seen.
